Please join us for a ribbon cutting ceremony on Wednesday, October 2, 2019 at 4:00PM at the West Promenade entrance to the soccer field where Octagon Field will be re-opened to the public and re-named **Jack McManus Field**. If you are attending, please consider wearing sneakers to protect the field.

No high-heeled shoes will be allowed on the playing surface.

After the Event: Still a Construction Area

Although the field will be available for public use, areas adjacent to the field are still under construction. A significant amount of fencing and construction activity part of ongoing Phase II Comfort Station work will continue through Spring 2020.

There will be limited access to Jack McManus Field as indicated on the diagram above. Temporary portable toilets - one ADA and one regular – will be installed this week for patrons to use during soccer season.

No Permitting Until October 28, 2019

In gratitude of the community's patience during construction, Jack McManus Field will not be subject to permits until October 28th. Soon, RIOC will announce the new permitting schedule that will go into effect on October 28, 2019.
